Global Kids Providing Virtual Spaces for Youth Collaboration

Global Kids continues to use the latest technology to bring youth voices together, and create spaces where these voices are heard.

This organization is using the NING website for youth to collaborate, work together and maintain communication. It gives youth a virtual and safe space to collaborate and meet youth from other schools, as well as participate in fun activities and daily actions. Combined with a calendar and an area for resources, it's a one-stop shop for GK participants.

New York Edge Teach Rock

NY Edge has collaborated with multi-platinum producer Little Stevie Van Zandt and his Rock and Roll Forever foundation to provide participants with music-driven after school programming online!



The program gathers participants online and used popular music to

introduce key concepts remotely alongside regular after-school offerings for all ages of youth! Music brings participants and staff together while also teaching important concepts such as SEL, math, STEAM, and language arts to young people.



SCO Family of Services CFL at 50's and Sunset Leaders

In addition, SCO presents "Group Time" sessions to engage participants in purposeful activities and guided conversations, providing an important opportunity for youth to express themselves and connect with one another during this period of social isolation. Activities range from kids and staff introducing pets, to talking about how much they miss one another, to creating a



space where people can safely express feelings and ask questions.

The organization introduced "Sunset Leaders," offering a variety of programs and services to the community, including operating Recreation Center and Food Pantry programs during the pandemic. The Sunset Leaders team launched virtual after-school program activities that include virtual clubs for participants, such as fashion, visual arts, and music troupes, mentors in training programming, gender and sexuality groups, and TGIF options for participants. The staff are also supported through trainings in online policies, individual supervision and mindfulness spaces to alleviate mental stress.
